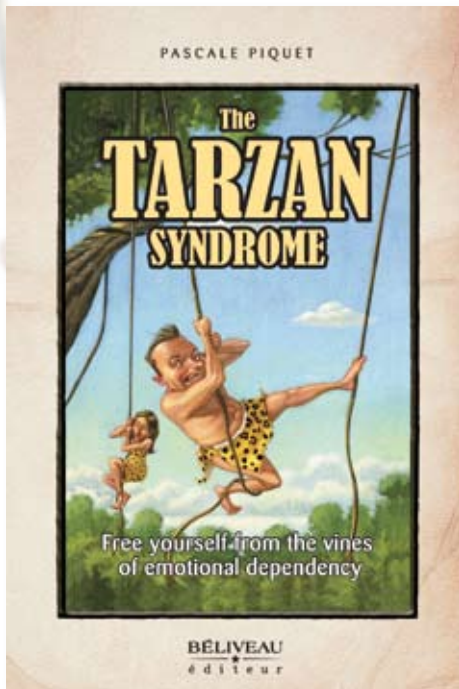


Free yourself from the vines that keep you from being happy in a relationship...

Master in NLP (Neuro-Linguistic-Programming), trained in hypnosis, Shiatsu, and total biology, Pascale uses all sorts of communication methods to create awareness of this cancer of the soul, and provides tools to eliminate it: coaching, one-on-one intensives, conferences, videos, radio and television chronicles, not to mention her best selling book in Europe and Quebec, The Tarzan Syndrome.

Pascale Piquet is from France. She was one of the first female jockeys on the great Parisian racetracks, her race career spanning fifteen years. After working as an assistant director, veterinary assistant for racehorses, and broker, Pascale created her Special Events Agency, Paris Prestige Hippique, in partnership with her father.

In 1994, she gave birth to a baby girl, Cassandre. Cheated on six months into her marriage while six months pregnant, Pascale used her rage against her husband (whom she almost killed) and his mistress by channeling it into martial arts. In France, she worked alongside some of the top names in publicity

such as Daniel Dahan at DMB&B and Denis Quénard at BDDP@TBWA. She ended her career in France, having worked hand in hand with the current President of MacDonald's France, Jean-Pierre Petit.

In March 2001, Pascale Piquet established herself in Quebec on a ninety-acre farm in Saint-Jean-de-Matha, accompanied by her daughter and second husband. Nine months later, she had him evicted by two police officers. Financially ruined, heartbroken, jobless and alone in a foreign land, she began her long uphill climb to understanding why she systematically reproduces the same patterns with men.

To regain her financial pride, she became a freelance journalist for Québec Franchise Magazine and a copywriter for ad agencies. She worked a thousand jobs to pay off her debts: alarm technician assistant, extra in the film Beyond Borders with Angelina Jolie, client manager for an equity firm, trapper, and the list goes on.

Her past experiences have made her stronger and Pascale now knows what she wants. Celibate for the last six years and a virgin again (just as criminal records are erased after four), her goal is to make LOVE with a MAN instead of having SEX with "neurotic overgrown babies." !



Pascale Piquet has written over 80 articles for magazines and The Web, in France and in Quebec. She's given over 60 interviews in Quebec City, Montreal, Trois-Rivieres, Sherbrooke, Tracy, Noranda, Sept-Îles, Havre Saint-Pierre, and New Brunswick: Live or taped, for radio, television, newspapers, and weekly columns.
